DEL MAR PERPETUAL TROPHY RALLY COURSE

START -----33° 42.700' N / 118° 28.600' W

CP-1: ----- On a Course of 195° Mag for 6.0 NM from START

CP-2: ----- On a Course of 195° Mag for 5.0 NM from CP-1

CP-3: ----- On a Course of 195° Mag for 4.4 NM from CP-2

CP-4: ----- Egel Rock ----- 100 YDS PORT

CP-5: ----- Ribbon Rock at Center of Depression ----- 200 YDS PORT

CP-6: ----- Whale Rock ----- 200 YDS PORT

FINISH: ----- Catalina Head Fl 4s 400ft 7M ----- 300 YDS PORT

(Official distance: 21.9 Nautical Miles.)

COURSE RULES SPECIAL CONTEST RULES

Note A: Vessels running the DEL MAR will plan their finish by 1400. No start time penalties will apply to the Del Mar Rally.

Special Rules and Equipment Allowed:

1. All equipment aboard the vessel may be used except that which is prohibited.
2. GPS SOG (speed over ground) and speed through the water is allowed in this contest.
3. Use of the following data from any source is prohibited:
Clock time, elapsed time, time to destination, or any other time-related value.
4. The contest will allow an Open Log.
5. Radio: Monitor VHF channel 71; skipper to announce 5 minutes to START if other contestant vessels are in the immediate vicinity.

ENTRY RESERVATIONS AND MOORINGS

The primary responsibility for obtaining a mooring at Cat Harbor rests with the contestant since DRYC is no longer able to guarantee mooring assignments for all. However, DRYC will send a list of expected vessels to the Two Harbors office based on receipt of the enclosed reservation form which must be mailed to DRYC before Wednesday, August 3rd. Contact Cat Harbor upon arrival via VHF 9 for mooring assignment. Cat Harbor moorings may be reserved online at: <https://www.visitcatalinaisland.com/two-harbors/mooring-reservations>. Otherwise, moorings are on a first-come, first-served basis upon arrival.

SKIPPER'S MEETING AND ACTUAL LOGS

There will be no Skippers' Meeting. Skippers must seal their Predicted Logs in an envelope and present it to the Observer before the start of the Rally, with separate log forms for each Rally. The Observer will maintain custody of all logs and official watch until presented to the Scorer, Tom Collins, in Cat Harbor aboard Misty Sea as soon as possible after arrival but not later than 1400.

OBSERVERS

Observers for this Rally may be immediate family members or crew members if qualified per current SCCA Rules.

TROPHY PRESENTATION AND DINNER

The trophies will be presented at a dinner to be held on Friday, August 12th, 2022 at Del Rey Yacht Club Cat Harbor facility beginning at 1730 hours. We will be sharing the facility with Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club who had also reserved it for their Clambake from DRYC. They will be providing buffet dinner on Friday, August 12, at the Del Rey YC in Cat Harbor.

The Friday cost is \$40/person inclusive and includes ribs, chicken, fish, salad, and dessert payable in advance. BCYC will also provide a cashless bar. Charge arrangements for the bar should be made at the time of payment for the dinner. If you want to add the buffet dinner with New York steaks and salmon on Saturday, August 13, is \$50/person inclusive. Add this to your arrangements with BCYC.

Note that BCYC has stated that we may bring our alcoholic beverages if we wish. Reservations and payment for dinner must be made in advance but not later than Wednesday, August 3rd by calling **BCYC** at **949-644-9530** with a credit card. Peel-Off will likely be done early so be on time!
