START: 33° 36.500' N / 118° 28.500' W	
CP-1 On a Course of 190° Mag for 3.0 NM from START	
CP-2: On a Course of 235° Mag for 5.0 NM from CP-1	
CP-3: Westend Light at the 50 Fathom Line	
CP-4: Eagle Rock at the 20 Fathom Line	
CP-5: Ribbon Rock at Center of Depression	- 200 YDS PORT
CP-6: Whale Rock	- 200 YDS PORT
FINISH: Catalina Head FI 4s 400ft 7M	- 300 YDS PORT
(Official distance: 17.2 Nautical Miles.)	

COURSE RULES SPECIAL CONTEST RULES

Note A: Be cautious of Vessels converging on the Start of Del Mar from Marina Del Rey and Vessels running the Kahlo Rally. If a Vessel from Marina Del Rey arrives at the Start of the Del Mar at the same time as a Kahlo Vessel the MDR Vessel must leave the Kahlo Vessel to PORT.

Note B: Vessels running the DEL MAR will plan their finish by 1300. No start time penalties will apply for the Del Mar Rally.

Special Rules and Equipment Allowed:

- 1. All equipment aboard the vessel may be used except that which is prohibited.
- 2. GPS SOG (speed over ground) and speed through the water is allowed in this contest.
- 3. Reference to any time function is prohibited: Clock time, elapsed time, time to destination, or any other time-related value.
- 4. The contest will_allow an Open Log. Skipper may have Actual Time at any Check Point during the Rally.
- 5. Radio: Monitor VHF channel 71

ENTRY RESERVATIONS AND MOORINGS

The primary responsibility for obtaining a mooring at Cat Harbor rests with the contestant since DRYC can no longer guarantee mooring assignments for all. However, DRYC will send a list of expected vessels to the Two Harbors office based on receipt of the enclosed reservation form which must be mailed to reach DRYC prior to Wednesday, August 2nd. Contact Cat Harbor upon arrival via VHF 9 for your mooring assignment. Cat Harbor moorings may be reserved online at: https://www.visitcatalinaisland.com/two-harbors/mooring-reservations. Otherwise, moorings are on a first-come, first-served basis upon arrival.

SKIPPERS' MEETING AND ACTUAL LOGS

There will be no Skippers' Meeting. Skippers must seal their Predicted Logs in an envelope and present it to the Observer prior to the start of the Rally, with separate log forms for each Rally. The Observer will maintain custody of all logs and official watch until presented to the Scorer, Tom Collins, in Cat Harbor aboard Misty Sea as soon as possible after arrival but not later than 1400.

OBSERVERS

Observers for this Rally may be immediate family members or crew members if qualified per current SCCA Rules.

TROPHY PRESENTATION AND DINNER

The trophies will be presented at a dinner to be held on Friday, August 11th, 2023 at the Del Rey Yacht Club Cat Harbor facility beginning at 1730 hours. We will be sharing the facility with Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club who had also reserved it for their Clambake from DRYC. They will be providing hors-d'oeuvres plus dinner. The cost will be \$50 per person. Dinner payment must be made before the Rally by calling BCYC at 949-644-9530 with a credit card. BCYC will provide a cashless bar with charges to your credit card at the DRYC Facility. No outside alcohol is allowed inside the DRYC compound except for wine. The corkage fee is \$10/bottle. Peel-Off will likely be done early so be on time!
