Rules: ------ SCCA Cruiser Navigation Contest Rules Feb. 15th, 2019, as amended. Communications:----- Skippers shall monitor VHF channel 16 for safety and 71 for contest information. Observers: ----- Family members OK as this is the feeder to an overnight contest. Race committee: ----- Tom Chandler (Cell: 310-849-3664) Committee boat: ----- RM II HYDE Skipper's meeting:----- None Official scorer: ----- Tom Collins –NO HANDICAP SCORING WILL BE USED. Predicted log: ----- To be sealed in an envelope and given to the observer before the contest. Actual log: ----- Use current SCCA log form; Turn in logs with official clock after the Del Mar contest to the scorer, Tom Collins, on the vessel Misty Sea as soon as possible after mooring, but no later than 1400 hours. Awards:----- In conjunction with the Del Mar awards in Cat Harbor.

Dress: ----- Casual beach attire.

The Course

Start: LONG BEACH LT FI 5s 50ft 14M HORN	70 yards starboard
WP-1Y "215" FI 5 Y 20s	40 yards starboard
CP-1: G "3" Q G	40 yards starboard
CP-2: Point Fermin Lt at 10 fm	starboard
CP-3: 33 41.0' N, 118 20.0' W	
CP-433 40.4' N, 118 23.5' W	
CP-5: 33 37.5' N, 118 26.0' W	
Finish*: 33 36.500' N, 118 28.500' W	
*FINISH of Kahlo and START for the Del Mar contest.	
(Official distance is approximately 17.5 nautical miles)	

RULES SPECIAL CONTEST RULES

GPS SOG (speed over ground) and speed through the water is allowed in this contest.

- 1. Plan a start time for the Jack Kahlo Memorial contest so as to allow sufficient time to finish the Del Mar and turn in the logs with the official clock to the scorer, Tom Collins, on the vessel *Misty Sea* as soon as possible after mooring but no later than 1400 hours. Also follow NOTE B: of the Del Mar Contest.
- 2. All equipment aboard the vessel may be used except that which is prohibited.
- 3. Use of the following data from any source is prohibited: Clock or elapsed time in any form.
- 4. The contest is an Open Log contest. During the contest the skipper may have access to all times recorded on the Actual Log.
- 5. Charts: Use NOAA San Pedro Channel charts corrected thru 05/01/2024.
- 6. Handicap WILL NOT be used in scoring.
- 7. The finish of the Kahlo is at the start point of the Del Mar.
- 8. See the Del Mar instructions for entry reservations, moorings, trophy information and dinner.
