WP-2:	LONG BEACH BREAKWATER Ent. light FI R 2.5s 41ft 5M "2"	100 yards port
CP-1:	Corner of MIDDLE BREAKWATER – inside B/W	75 yards port
WP-3:	PIER 400 Light "A" - after stbd. turn leave "A" to port 250	0-300 yards stbd
CP-2:	NAVAL BASE MOLE Light FI G 2.5s 26ft 5M "9"	100 yards port
WP-4:	PIER J Light FI R 2.5s 26ft 5M "8" 50	0-550 yards port
CP-3:	Buoy G "3" FI G 4s	50 yards port
WP-5:	Northwest Corner Island Freeman	100 yards stbd
CP-4:	Lighted Channel Buoy R "2" FI R 4s	50 yards port
CP-5:	Island Grissom Easternmost MARKERS (Lt)	100 yards port

Notes & Rules:

- 1 Start Time: Start at skipper's discretion to turn in logs by 1300.
- 2 Contest prepared using charts: 18749 44th Ed.
- Official distance: 15.2 nautical miles (your distance may vary depending on your distance off the marks).
- 4 No handicap.
- 5 Race communications: VHF 71.
- All equipment aboard the vessel may be used including GPS, chart plotters, etc., except that which is prohibited in item 7 below.
- 7 Use of the following data is prohibited: Clock time or elapsed time.
- This regatta will allow an open log where during the regatta the skipper may have access to all times that are recorded on the front and back of the Actual Log. Official waypoint times may be recorded on the back of the Actual Log. Waypoints 1 & 2 MUST be recorded for Easy Entry skippers.
- 9 Vessels should announce "Five minutes to start" via VHF 71.

2024 HHYC Cruiser Nav / Predicted Log Rally - Easy Entry


A special feature of this HHYC Season Closer Rally is the provision for Easy-Entry level skippers to enter without the need to run a measured mile in advance or prepare a predicted log! The course is just 15 miles entirely inside the LA/LB breakwater.

It's easy! All you need to do is submit the entry reservation and run the course. Call in advance and we'll answer any questions and even help you plan your run.

On Saturday morning - go to the start at the East end of the Long Beach Breakwater and start anytime before 11 and follow the course. Just run the course at the speed you normally cruise using your GPS to maintain that speed throughout the course - note your intended speed on the Actual Log. Your observer will record your clock-times on the Actual Log as you call MARK when you pass the course control points.

Once your Actual Log is submitted, the Committee will use the speed you chose to prepare a prediction for your boat then compute your score.

It's that simple! Come on out and join in the fun. You'll enjoy a nice cruise and have a chance of receiving a trophy at the HHYC awards dinner on Saturday night.
